

# Leave a legacy

**A legacy to the RSPCA Milton Keynes and North Bucks Branch will provide crucial funds. We could not carry out our work without your generous support.**

You can do this by making a will or by adding a codicil (a document which specifies alterations to your will). If you are making a will, please remember that the RSPCA Milton Keynes and North Bucks Branch and all the other RSPCA branches are separately registered charities. So, if you would like the animals in your local area to benefit, we would respectfully suggest that your legacy reads:

**I give the sum of £..... (or specify a share of residue) to the RSPCA Milton Keynes & North Bucks Branch, Registered Charity Number 275415, for its general purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer of the said RSPCA for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.**

Please note that a will or codicil needs to be properly witnessed, and you should obtain legal advice.

Gifts to registered charities are generally exempt from inheritance and capital gains taxes. A gift to the RSPCA Milton Keynes and North Bucks Branch would therefore greatly benefit the local animals with minimum burden to your estate.

recovered fully after his surgery and is now happily settled into his new home. Our volunteers not only provide the care and support to rehabilitate animals, but also provide advice to new owners about caring for the animals they adopt.
